11. buildings relied on thick, heavy walls to support their weight, limiting how tall they could be.  
12. Jenney’s design, however, used a steel skeleton to bear the weight, enabling architects to build  
13. taller and lighter structures.

14. This innovation couldn’t have come at a better time. Cities like Chicago and New York  
15. were growing rapidly due to industrialization, and urban land was becoming scarce and  
16. expensive. Taller buildings allowed more people and businesses to occupy the same area,  
17. maximizing the use of limited space. Jenney’s invention inspired other architects to experiment  
18. with steel-frame designs, and soon skyscrapers began to rise across the United States.

19. By the early 20th century, skyscrapers had become symbols of power and ambition.  
20. Famous examples like the Empire State Building in New York City and the Willis Tower  
21. in Chicago became icons of American innovation. They were not just offices or apartments but  
22. statements of what was possible with modern technology.

23. Over the years, skyscrapers have continued to evolve. New materials, such as reinforced  
24. concrete and advanced glass, have allowed buildings to become even taller while remaining  
25. safe and energy-efficient. Today, skyscrapers are found all over the world, from Asia to the  
26. Middle East, often breaking records in height. While skyscrapers are impressive, they also face  
27. challenges. They require enormous amounts of energy to operate, and their construction often  
28. has environmental impacts. Architects and engineers are now focusing on creating sustainable
